



NABP CPE Monitor

The National Association of Boards of Pharmacy® (NABP®) launched the NABP CPE Monitor™ service in March 2011. A collaborative effort with the Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education (ACPE), CPE Monitor is an electronic tracking system for continuing pharmacy education (CPE). The service authenticates and stores data for pharmacists' and pharmacy technicians' completed CPE units.

Benefits

The CPE Monitor Service is expected to:

- ✓ Save the state boards of pharmacy, CPE providers, pharmacists, and technicians time and cost.
- ✓ Provide participating boards with a streamlined process to verify their licensees' and registrants' compliance with CPE requirements.
- ✓ Provide a secure, central location for pharmacists and technicians to maintain and track all completed ACPE-accredited CPE credits.
- ✓ Streamline processes for pharmacists licensed in multiple states.
- ✓ Provide 24/7 access online to pharmacists and technicians.

How does the program work?

- ✓ Pharmacists and pharmacy technicians will set up an NABP e-Profile on the NABP Web site and obtain their permanent identification number, or NABP e-Profile ID.
- ✓ As ACPE-accredited CPE providers begin transitioning their systems to CPE Monitor throughout 2012, pharmacists and pharmacy technicians will need to begin providing their NABP e-Profile ID and date of birth to the provider when they register for CPE or submit a request for credit.
