- ✓ Policies are:

 - educational programming, and
 - official comments to outside entities.
- ✓ Specifically, Professional Affairs oversees:
 - Task force and committee meetings and follow-up actions
 - Compliance with Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education Accreditation Standards for continuing pharmacy education providers
 - NABP meeting educational programming
 - Certain NABP Annual Meeting preparations
 - Executive Office publications
 - Certain legislative and regulatory monitoring (in concert with Government Affairs Department)

 - Offers complete and updated compilation of the pharmacy practice acts, controlled substance acts, wholesale drug distributor acts, and accompanying regulations for all 50 states and the District of Columbia
