



Pre-NAPLEX

In 2003, the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy® unveiled the Pre-NAPLEX®. The Pre-NAPLEX is the only North American Pharmacist Licensure Examination™ (NAPLEX®) practice examination written and developed by NABP to familiarize students with the NAPLEX testing experience.

- ✓ The Pre-NAPLEX offers pharmacy students and graduates an opportunity to assess their ability, knowledge, and judgment as those qualities pertain to the expectations of an entry-level pharmacist.
- ✓ Because the Pre-NAPLEX is similar to the actual NAPLEX in many ways, students who take the Pre-NAPLEX will have a chance to “preview” the NAPLEX experience before examination day.
- ✓ The items on the Pre-NAPLEX are actual items that have previously appeared on the NAPLEX.
- ✓ The Pre-NAPLEX is a 70-minute, Internet-based examination that consists of 50 items. More than one form of the Pre-NAPLEX is available.
- ✓ The current fee for the Pre-NAPLEX is \$50.
- ✓ The Pre-NAPLEX can be taken up to two times and may be taken at any time on any day.
- ✓ Students who complete the Pre-NAPLEX will be given an estimated, scaled score similar to what he or she can expect to receive on the NAPLEX, but may not be the actual score attained, nor is it a guarantee of passing the actual NAPLEX.
- ✓ To take the Pre-NAPLEX, a computer running either Microsoft Windows or Mac OS operating system software is required.
