



Pre-FPGEE

L launched in 2003, the Pre-FPGEE® is the only Foreign Pharmacy Graduate Equivalency Examination® (FPGEE®) practice examination written and developed by the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy®. The Pre-FPGEE is meant to help familiarize students with the types of items an applicant may encounter on the FPGEE. The Pre-FPGEE is intended to benefit pharmacy students who are preparing for the FPGEE. However, anyone who is interested may register and take the Pre-FPGEE; there are no eligibility requirements to take the Pre-FPGEE.

- ✓ The questions on the Pre-FPGEE are actual questions that have previously appeared on the FPGEE. The form contains items based on the same blueprint used for the FPGEE.
- ✓ To take the Pre-FPGEE, a computer running either Microsoft Windows or Mac OS operating system software is required.
- ✓ The Pre-FPGEE is an 85-minute, Internet-based examination that consists of 66 questions. This time limit is proportional to the time allowed on the FPGEE.
- ✓ The current fee for the Pre-FPGEE is \$50.
- ✓ Since only one form of the Pre-FPGEE is available the examination cannot be taken more than one time.
- ✓ In preparation for the Pre-FPGEE, applicants are encouraged to review the FPGEE competency statements and the associated knowledge base of a recent United States pharmacy school graduate.
- ✓ Similar to other practice examinations, an applicant's score on the Pre-FPGEE is similar to what he or she can expect to receive on the FPGEE, but may not be the actual score attained, nor is it a guarantee of passing the actual examination.
