



## NABP State Relations

**S**upport to the boards of pharmacy is provided through state relations efforts, which are intended to foster and enhance communication between the National Association of Boards of Pharmacy® (NABP®) and the state boards.

- ✓ NABP staff works with the state boards of pharmacy on educational, legislative, and regulatory issues to ensure that NABP members receive the information and support they need to develop, implement, and enforce uniform standards for the purpose of regulating the profession and protecting the public health in their respective states.
- ✓ State relations efforts include:
  - Tracking and monitoring critical state and federal legislation that may impact the state boards of pharmacy.
  - Assisting the boards of pharmacy by reviewing and providing feedback on proposed legislation and regulations.
  - Providing written and/or in-person testimony to legislative committees upon request from member boards.
  - Participating in board of pharmacy meetings and deliberations, conference calls, or legislative summits to assist the states with pharmacy issues.
