

Statistical Analysis of MPJE® Passing Rates per Pharmacy School from 2002 to 2006

The following table indicates the passing percentages for Multistate Pharmacy Jurisprudence Examination® (MPJE®) candidates who were graduates from ACPE accredited United States schools and colleges of pharmacy between 2002 and 2006. School passing percentages include the results of all graduates taking the MPJE in multiple jurisdictions (if applicable) and are not solely reflective of the graduates from that year. This data may be useful to the state boards of pharmacy as well as the schools and colleges of pharmacy.
