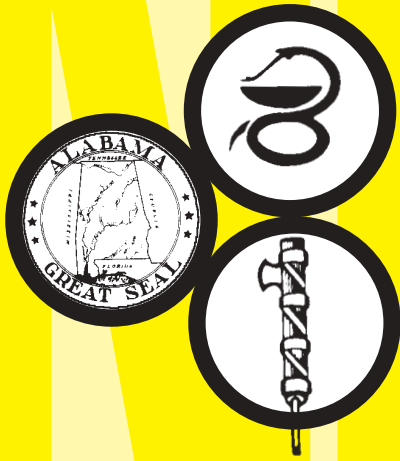

Alabama State Board of Pharmacy

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Published to promote voluntary compliance of pharmacy and drug law.

680-X-2-.27 Private Consultation Areas for Pharmacies

This reads in part "... private consultation areas must be furnished by pharmacy owners ... All existing pharmacies must be in compliance on or before **January 1, 2005.**"

Only Pharmacists May Have Keys (680-X-2-.11)

This reads in part "... **At all times registered Pharmacists designated by the licensee must have all keys in their possession.**"

Administrative Hearing – June 2003 Through September 2003

Pharmacists' names: **Nancy Kickliter** #9392, **Lamar White** #11828; Pharmacy's name: **Auburn University Student Health Center Pharmacy** #110704. Allowing pharmacy to remain open and/or allowing prescriptions to be picked up without a pharmacist being present; allowing individuals who were not registered as technicians to be present in the prescription department. Action – (pharmacists) administrative penalty; successfully retake law exam. Action – (pharmacy) one year's probation; administrative penalty.

Pharmacist's name: **James B. Gillespie** #7004; Pharmacy's name: **The Medicine Shoppe** #110709. Dispensing legend drugs without a prescription; creating false or fraudulent prescriptions. Action – (pharmacist) administrative penalty. Action – (pharmacy) probation five years; administrative penalty.

Pharmacist's name: **Jon Kevin Howell** #11748; Pharmacy's name: **Pinson Pharmacy** #107800. Conviction in United States District Court of distribution of a controlled substance; submitting fraudulent claims to Blue Cross/Blue Shield of Alabama; practicing pharmacy without being licensed by the Alabama State Board of Pharmacy. Action – (pharmacy) revoked. Action – (pharmacist) suspended 30 years, may apply for a hearing after 15 years.

Pharmacist's name: **Tommy Ray McDougal** #6075. Wrongfully taking property belonging to another. Action – Probation, administrative penalty; successfully retake law exam.

Pharmacist's name: **Paul Hopkins Young, Sr** #13896. Dispensing Schedule II and III controlled substances without a prescription; failing to maintain inventories and records. Action – Suspended for seven years; after two years, suspension shall be reverted to probation; administrative penalty; successfully retake law exam.

Pharmacist's name: **Robert L. Atkinson** #4690; Pharmacy's name: **The Prescription Shop** #108030; Technician's name: **Lona May Miller** #T00056. Allowing someone other than a licensed pharmacist to have possession of a key to pharmacy; allowing technician to be present in prescription department while not under the direct supervision of a licensed pharmacist; allowing pharmacy to be open for business without the personal supervision of a duly licensed pharmacist. Action – Probation for one year; administrative penalty.

Pharmacist's name: **William John Cox** #11454; Pharmacy's name: **Cox Nuclear Pharmacy, Inc** #102861. Allowing someone other than a licensed pharmacist to have possession of a key to pharmacy; allowing technician to be present in prescription department while not under the direct supervision of a licensed pharmacist; allowing pharmacy to be open for business without the personal supervision of a duly licensed pharmacist; allowing technicians to accept and/or receive oral prescriptions over the telephone. Action – Probation three years; administrative penalty.

Technician's name: **Allison L. Dale** #T06227. Testing positive for marijuana; dispensing Schedule III controlled substances without a prescription. Action – Revoked.

Technician's name: **Patricia Mason Evans** #T00621. Dispensing Schedules III and IV controlled substances and/or legend drugs without a prescription; stealing cash from employer. Action – Revoked.

Pharmacist's name: **Bernard Moore** #6024. Violations occurring in Georgia. Action – Probation; cannot be supervising pharmacist; shall not own a pharmacy during probation.

Technician's name: **Jaye Rodney Wilson** #T06799. Dispensing Schedules III and IV controlled substances and/or legend drugs without a prescription, conviction in Circuit Court of Jefferson County of theft of property. Action – Revoked.

Technicians' names: **Renee Bishop** #T01638; **Diane Griffen** #T01775. Present in pharmacy department while not under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist. Action – Probation one year; administrative penalty.

Pharmacist's name: **Gerald Max Bureson** #6684. Failing as supervising pharmacist to ensure that prescription department was operated in good pharmaceutical practices. Action – Probation five years; administrative penalty.

Pharmacy's name: **City Pharmacy of Haleyville** #102490. Operated as a pharmacy without being duly permitted. Action – Probation five years; administrative penalty.

Pharmacist's name: **Luke Drury Coburn** #10812. Pharmacy's name: **The Medicine Shoppe #903**, #106762. Dispensing Schedules III and IV controlled substances and/or legend drugs without a prescription; accepting and/or returning to stock returned prescriptions; allowing someone other than a licensed pharmacist to have possession of a key to pharmacy; submitting to Blue Cross/Blue Shield claims for reimbursement when drugs were not dispensed. Action – Pharmacist's license suspended five years/revert to probation after six months; inventory of controlled substances quarterly; administrative penalty. Pharmacy's permit suspended five years/revert to probation immediately; administrative penalty.

Pharmacist's name: **Susannah Cripps Daughtry** #13130. Working in pharmacy when that pharmacy did not possess a current pharmacy permit; failing as supervising pharmacist to ensure prescription department operated with good pharmaceutical practices. Action – Probation one year; successfully retake law exam; administrative penalty.

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Technician's name: **Sueanne Brooke Fleming Hopwood** #T08544.

Dispensing Schedule III controlled substances without prescription; conviction in District Court of Jefferson County of theft of property. Action – Revoked.

Pharmacists' names: **Lyauro Alicia Venegas Johnson** #11185; **Bobby Allan Pannell** #13604; **Ralph Curtin Wasson, Jr** #4129. Allowing someone other than a licensed pharmacist to have possession of a key to pharmacy; allowing technician to be present in prescription department while not under the direct supervision of a licensed pharmacist; allowing pharmacy to be open for business without the personal supervision of a duly licensed pharmacist. Action – Probation one year; administrative penalty; successfully retake licensing exam.

Technician's name: **Chasity Marie Kemp** #T09937. Dispensing Schedules III and IV controlled substances without prescription. Action – Revoked.

Technician's name: **Yasmine H. Sieber** #T02824. Present in pharmacy department while not under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist. Action – Administrative penalty.

Technician's name: **Stuart Holland Turner** #T00084. Conviction District Court of Madison County. Action – Suspended indefinitely.

Pharmacists' names: **John David Kelley** #7726; **Chandler Thomas Willingham** #12006; **Garry Donald Boggus** #9916; **Nathan Moore Berck** #14573. Substituting and dispensing a different drug or brand in lieu of that ordered or prescribed without the express permission of an authorized practitioner. Action – Administrative penalty.

Technicians' names: **Jeanna Burnette Guess** #T04509; **Jana B. Suggs** #T05303. Working as a technician without timely renewing and possessing a current registration. Action – Administrative penalty.

Pharmacists' names: **Belinda Pitts Ballard** #10506; **William Bedford Ponder** #6105. Allowing technician to work without a current registration. Action – Administrative penalty.

Pharmacies' names: **North Jackson Pharmacy** #107218; **Walgreens** #112003; **Walgreens #06488**, #111962; **CVS/Pharmacy #4858**, #110845; **Rite Aid #7176**, #105775. Allowing technician to perform technician functions without a current registration. Action – Administrative penalty.

Manufacturer/Wholesaler/Distributors' names: **Watson Pharma, Inc** #192240; **Taylor Pharmaceuticals** #191973; **Roxane Laboratories, Inc** #190230; **Lifegas, Ltd** #500405; **Ethex Corporation** #191602; **McKesson Drug Company** #192158; **Holox, Ltd** #500372; **Ther-Rx Corporation** #192109; **Patterson Dental Supply, Inc** #191794; **PSS World Medical, Inc** #192279; Engaging in activities as a manufacturer/wholesaler/distributor during the year 2003 without first having renewed permit. Action – Administrative penalty.

Nonresident pharmacies' names: **Artex Medical, Inc** #112051/200957; **Speed Scripts** #112121/201005. Engaging in the selling, offering for sale, compounding or dispensing drugs during 2003 without first renewing permit. Action – Administrative penalty. Manufacturer/Wholesaler/Distributor's name: **ICN Pharmaceuticals, Inc** #190200. Conviction in United States District Court for the Central District of California. Action – Probation one year; administrative penalty.

Reminder

Renewals for 2004 were sent to all licensees in October 2003. Fees for renewals are due on January 1 each year and are delinquent after the last day of February of each year. Failure to pay a renewal fee will result in the certificate becoming null and void.

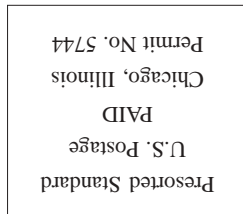
